Disposal Instructions for Empty Tanks

- 1. Spray until the tank is completely empty and the spray gun does not emit any more glue and propellant.
- 2. Close the valve on the tank.
- 3. Then continue with the hose and spray until no more glue or propellant is emitted.
- 4. Turn the small cog behind the handle to close the gun and detach the hose from the empty tank. If possible, attach it to a new tank immediately, to avoid glue remnants from hardening within the hose. Open the valve as soon as the hose is attached to the new tank.
- 5. Now open the valve of the empty tank in a well-vented room, to make sure that the propellant has escaped completely from the tank.
- 6. Perforate the empty tank at the predetermined breaking point next to the valve.





- 7. Remove the hazardous goods label.
- 8. The tank now counts as scrap iron and can be disposed of.
